To get on [your] high horse




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



One day, a man was born with a pig head.

Every one told him he had a pig head but he didn't believe it, he thought it was impossible.


They kept telling him to look at a mirror to see for himself, but he refused to obey. He was too stubborn.

From that day on, people call anyone stubborn "Pig Headed"






It's raining cats and dogs!








When pigs fly


A pig wanted to fly like birds since he started walking. A fairy appeared to him and granted his wish. He could fly like a bird!

↳ Family member that is different from the rest of the family.






TO GET ON YOUR HIGH HORSES
